

Community Health Workers Program Intern

Number of positions available: 1-3 Intern positions. Interns may job-share, working one or more weeks at a time.

Virtual or In-person: Mostly in person (at John R Lewis High School) and some virtual

Eligibility requirements: ELP II or ELP III participant

Internship dates: First cohort June 21 – July 11. Second cohort mid-July to Mid-August

Working hours: Attend each class (9 am – 3:30 daily) in person. Total hours: ~ 30 hours per week.

Supervisor: Andrea Scott, Program Manager Youth Ambassador

Responsibilities:

- Assist in classroom during the cohort (take attendance, manage class materials, be available to students during lunch)
- Assist with class preparation – materials, contacting attendees
- Shadow high school students in their health practicum work
- Take photos during class to document the course
- Collect registration and attendance data for each class
- Promote the program
- Attend each class, take notes and provide a short feedback report to the supervisor on the program (what went well, what could be improved, what was most interesting, what was not interesting, how was the class reacting, etc.)

Desired skills:

- **Interest in healthcare and health related fields**
- English fluency
- Either Spanish fluency or interest in learning Spanish
- Good listening skills
- Work well with high school students
- Good organizational skills
- Interest in supporting underserved communities
